The 65th Caddo Conference will be held April 26th and 27th, 2024, at the Don Tyson Center for Agricultural Sciences at the University of Arkansas, in Fayetteville. Nestled in the Ozark Mountains of northwest Arkansas, Fayetteville and its neighboring cities offer numerous cultural institutions, outdoor activities, restaurants, and other attractions. We are eager to welcome you to this thriving part of our state, which lies in the northern portion of the Caddo homeland, an area to which the Osages and Quapaws also trace their history.
